Overview

- £4.9mil under Wave 3 Skills Bootcamps, DfE funding under the Skills for Life campaign (courses running up until 31st March 2022)
- Wave 3 DfE policy extends into Green, Construction, Technical, Logistics and Pathways to Apprenticeships
- Construction, Green and Logistics curriculum Level 2 (or equivalent) upwards, all others are to be Level 3 upwards
- Summer procurement activity not all Lots received bids contracted with 7 successful Training Providers across Construction, Digital and Green
- Direct proposals from interested Training Providers including Engineering & Welding, Digital including Coding and Games Programmer/UX

Overview

- Courses on offer are available to view through the Growth Works webpages, linking directly to the Training Provider for application
- Employers have access to up to 90% funding per employee for upskilling
- 100% fully funded for self-employed, unemployed
- Learners are currently on programme, mixture between co-funded upskilling, self-employed and unemployed
- Providers are recruiting for future cohort dates
- Delivery largely remote and flexible
