	Cllr Anna Smith (Chair of the Transport & Infrastructure Committee)	Mr Anthony Carpen	In order to provide a truly, sustainable and integrated transport network, rail has to play a key role in offering appropriate choices for people and businesses, especially those involved in the movement of freight. The Combined Authority has been successful in attracting funding and focus from government and other partners in recent years, such as the opening of

Soham Station and money for Cambridge South Station. It is essential that the Combined Authority continue to work with strategic stakeholders to promote, champion and lobby for the necessary improvements within the rail network and therefore the assistance of Rail Futures will be a key in our approach.
I would therefore like to extend an invitation to Rail Futures to attend our Rail Summit in July where conversations can commence with elected members and officers alike.
