Recommendations: The Combined Authority Board is recommended to:

- a) Recommend the CA Board approve allocation of £1.963m for the delivery of ZEBRA buses, subject to funds being available following a review of existing Transforming Cities Fund commitments
- b) Recommend the CA Board delegate authority to the Head of Transport, in consultation of the Mayor, authority to deliver the ZEBRA buses. This is subject to the DfT application being approved.

Voting arrangements:

A vote in favour by at least two thirds of all Members (or their Substitute Members) appointed by the Constituent Councils present and voting, to include the Members appointed by Cambridgeshire County Council or Peterborough City Council, or their Substitute Members.

Any vote in favour must include the vote of the Mayor, or the Deputy Mayor acting in place of the Mayor, to be carried.

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The report to the Transport and Infrastructure Committee on 8 September 2021 provided a progress update on the ZEBRA (Zero Emission Bus Regional Area) Phase 2 Application. It also set out the funding required as the Combined Authority's contribution should the bid be successful.
