- Lead on careers education in the region, aligning the offer to local needs and demands coordinating multiple partner and stakeholder relationships.
- Implement, drive and own the Careers Hub strategic plan that harmonises local economic and skills priorities and achieves sustained change in careers provision
- Drive the performance of the CEC contract for the schools in the Hub and within the EANR
- Long term planning for future academic years and the transition of all schools in the region to a Careers Hub
