- b) Approve the expansion of the current E-bike network region wide and to work with officers in constituent authorities and cycle groups to agree the exact location for the installation of the electric bike sites.

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The Board is invited to consider the outcome of the Department for Transport (DfT) e-scooter trial operating in Cambridge City Centre since October 2020 and to approve extending the trial to March 2022. The Board is further recommended to approve expanding the current e-bike network region wide and to investigate potential locations in with constituent councils and cycle groups.
- 1.2 These proposals were considered by the Transport and Infrastructure Committee on 8 September 2021. Following discussion, the Committee resolved unanimously to recommend the proposals to the Combined Authority Board for approval.
