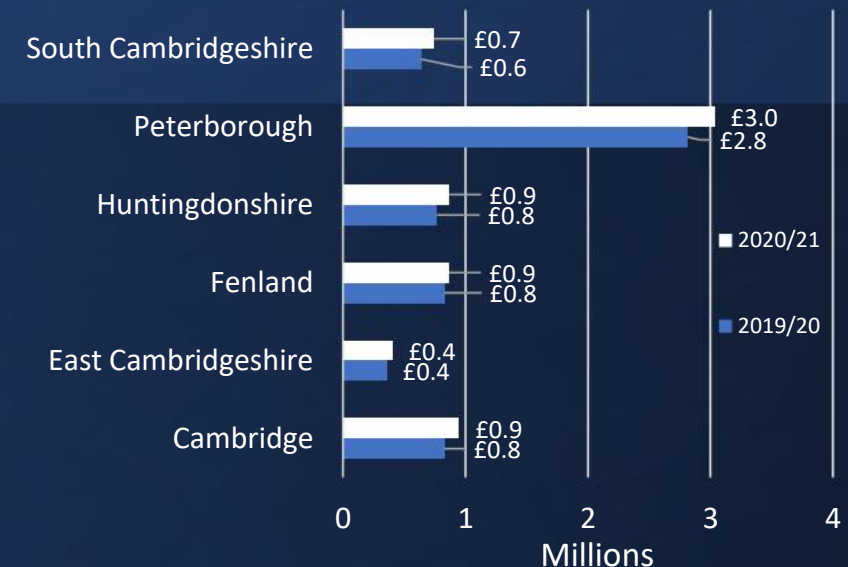

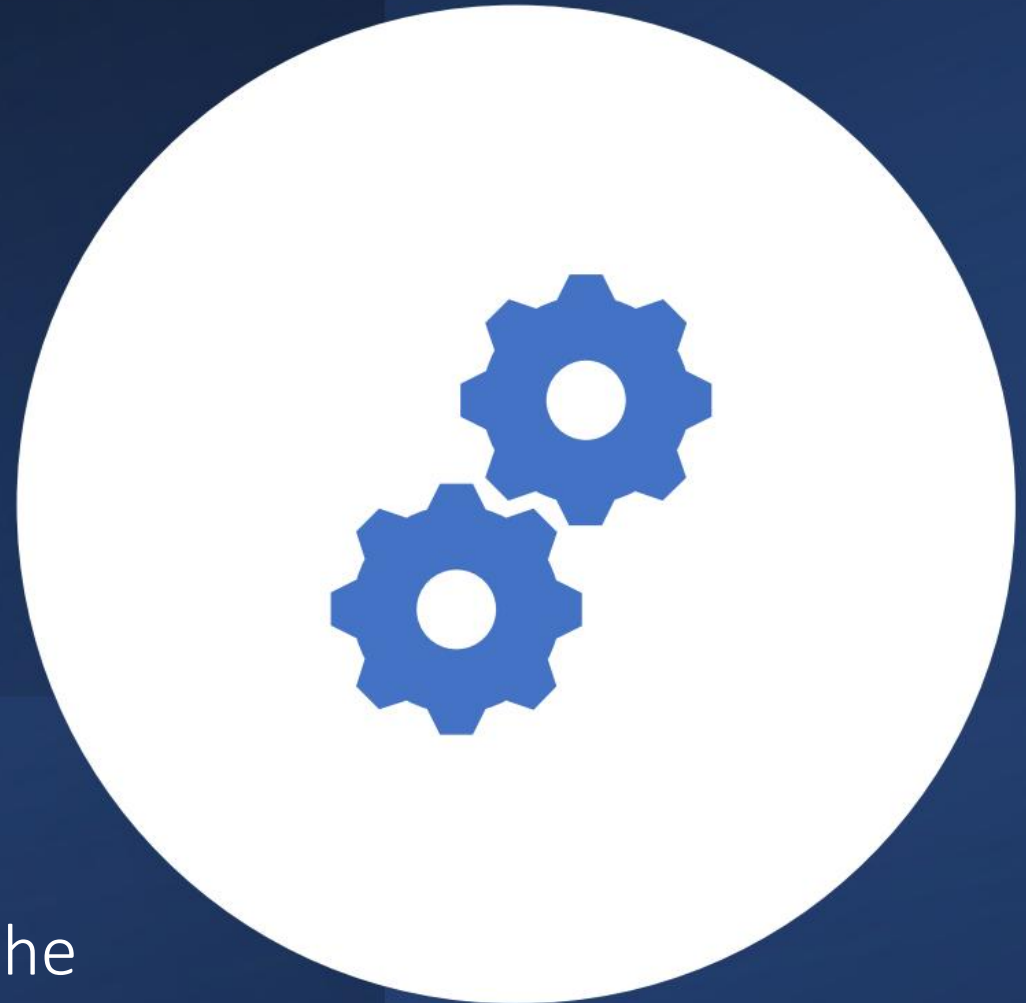

- 5) Open public consultation launches 15 Feb – 14 March for policy changes



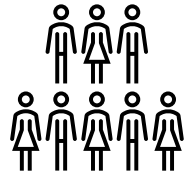

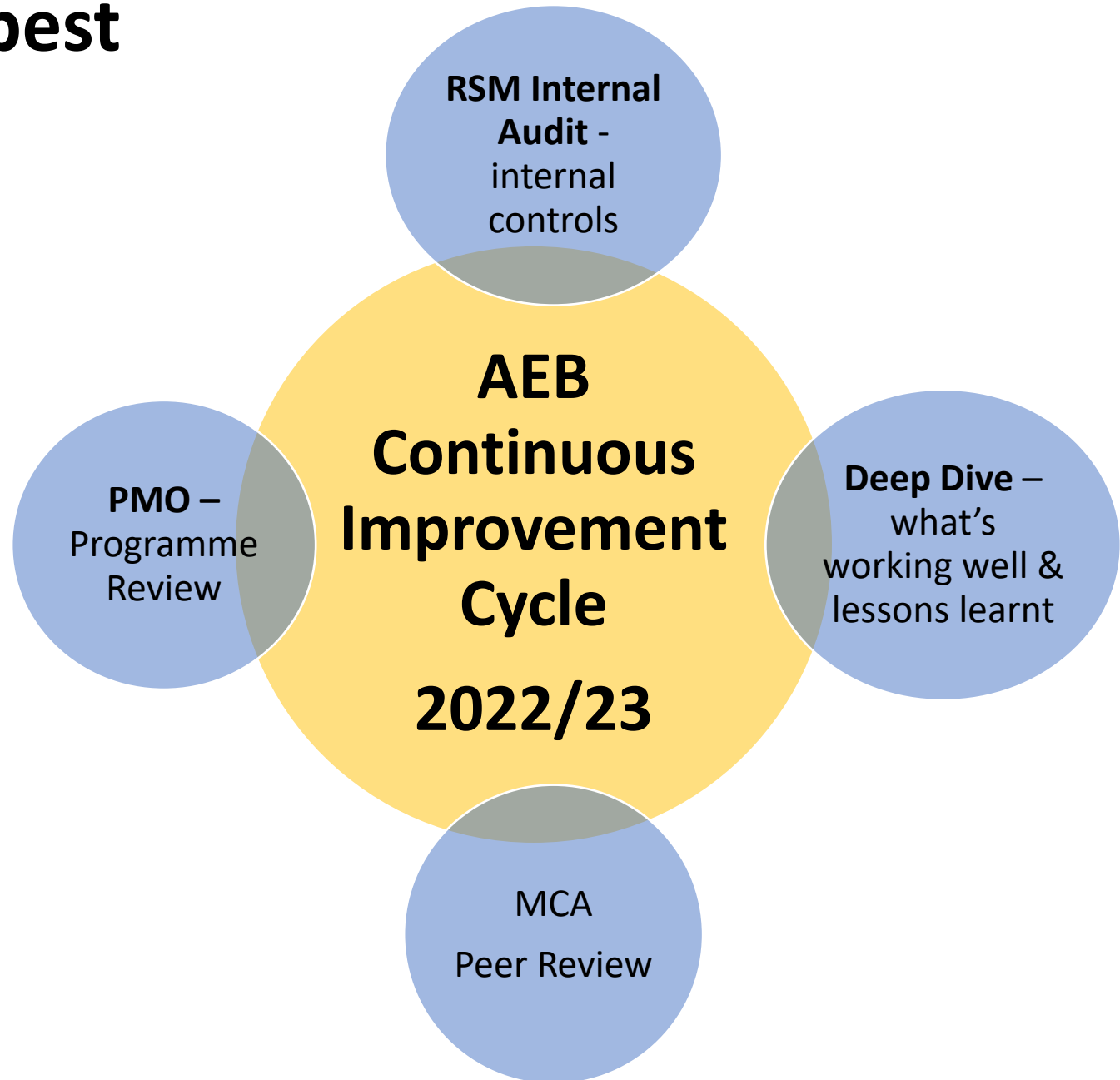
